RAINIER TENT LINER TechTips

LEG DRAPE INSTALLATION

Attach hooks onto the sidewall rope beginning at the leg.

Hook #1

Start at the outside.

Hook #2

Out to the left, until fabric is taut.

Hook #3

Back to the leg, inside of tent.

Hook #4

Next to leg, creating the corner.

Hook #5

Out to left, until fabric is taut.

Hook #6

Back to outside of tent next to hook #1.

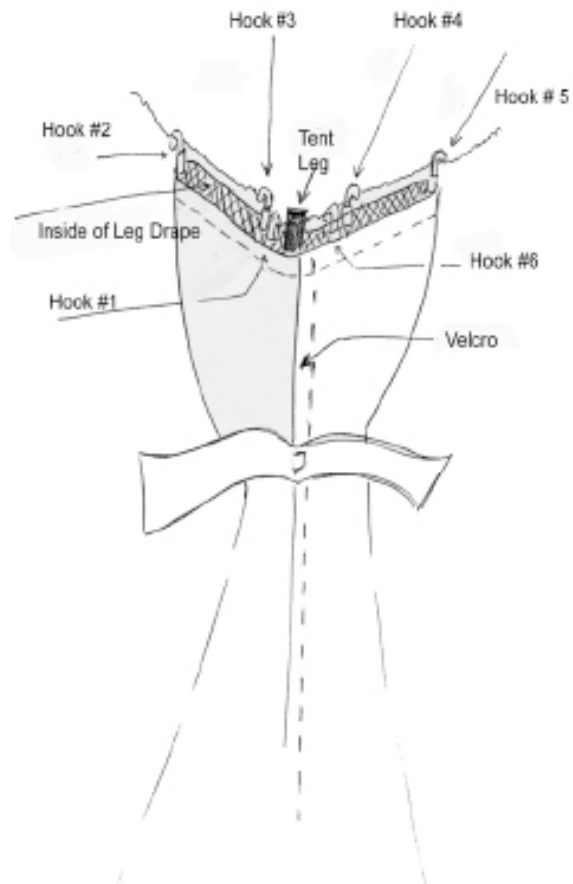
Connect the Velcro strips together from top to bottom, easing to finish even at the bottom hem.

Place the leg tie at the desired height by opening a small section of the Velcro and insert the Velcro "seam". Wrap the tie toward the front (inside) of the tent and knot as desired. The Velcro tab will keep the leg and tie at the desired height and can support theme décor/ floral etc. as desired.

The leg drape can be bloused, as you desire.

NOTE: The knot will have to be fairly tight to hold blouse effect in breezy conditions.

Try different heights for the leg tie for a variety of looks!
