

Installing Hooks and Cords to Sidewall Extensions

Preparation

Making sidewall extension properly is a function of keeping the over-flap tied down. Installing shock cords and sidewall tent hooks should do the job.

Installation of Sidewall Tent Hooks and Shock Cords

- 1. Install 4" x 4" doubler (reinforcement) on existing wall. Punch 1/4" hole for Stayput Hooks
- 2. Assemble Stayput hooks by tapping with hammer until button is set into fabric.
- 3. Each sidewall should have four (4) Stayput sidewall hooks.
- Position each hook so the shock cord fits snuggly when snapped into place.
 NOTE Do not place too low on wall, making the shock cord stretch when it is connected.
- 5. Install Shock Cords if necessary
